

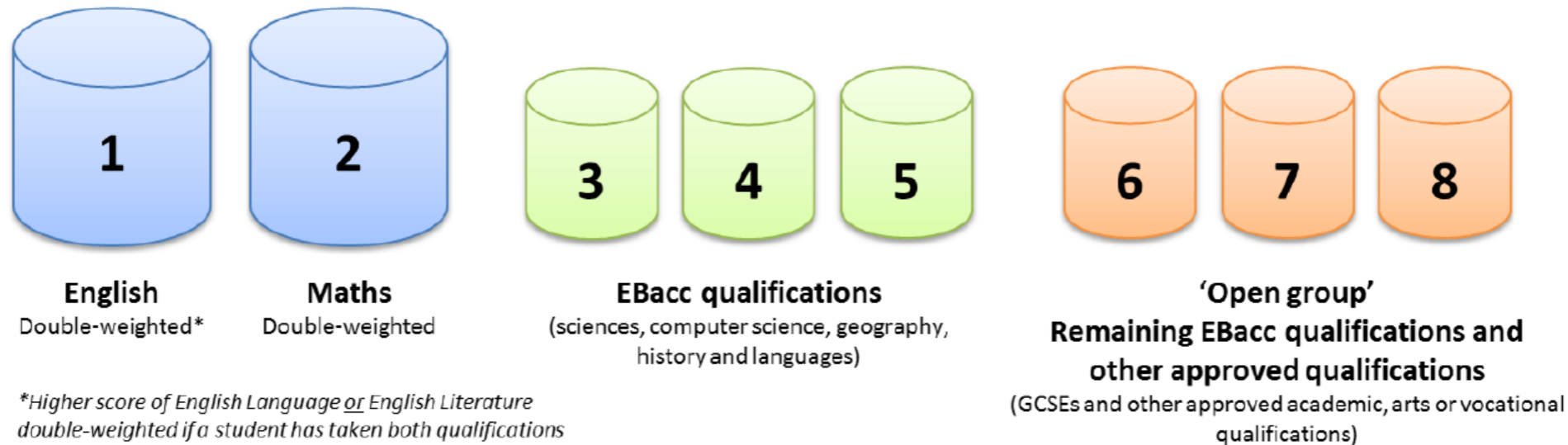




# Progress 8

- **Changes to Education – A Parent’s Guide**
- Accountability in school terms means a policy of holding the school accountable for students’ academic progress (the results we publish)
- It is also linked to the accountability that students have for their own progress and achievements.
- **Progress 8**
- Currently all students and schools are measured on **how many GCSE’s they achieve at A\*-C including English and Mathematics. From 2016 all students will be measured on how much progress they make from when they started in Year 7 to when they complete their exams at the end of Year 11.**
- This will be known as **Progress 8.**
- Progress 8 will be introduced for all students and is designed to encourage all students to study a **broad and balanced curriculum.**
- The new measure will be based **on students’ progress measured across eight subjects. For each student the 8 subjects must be a combination from their options.**

# Progress 8



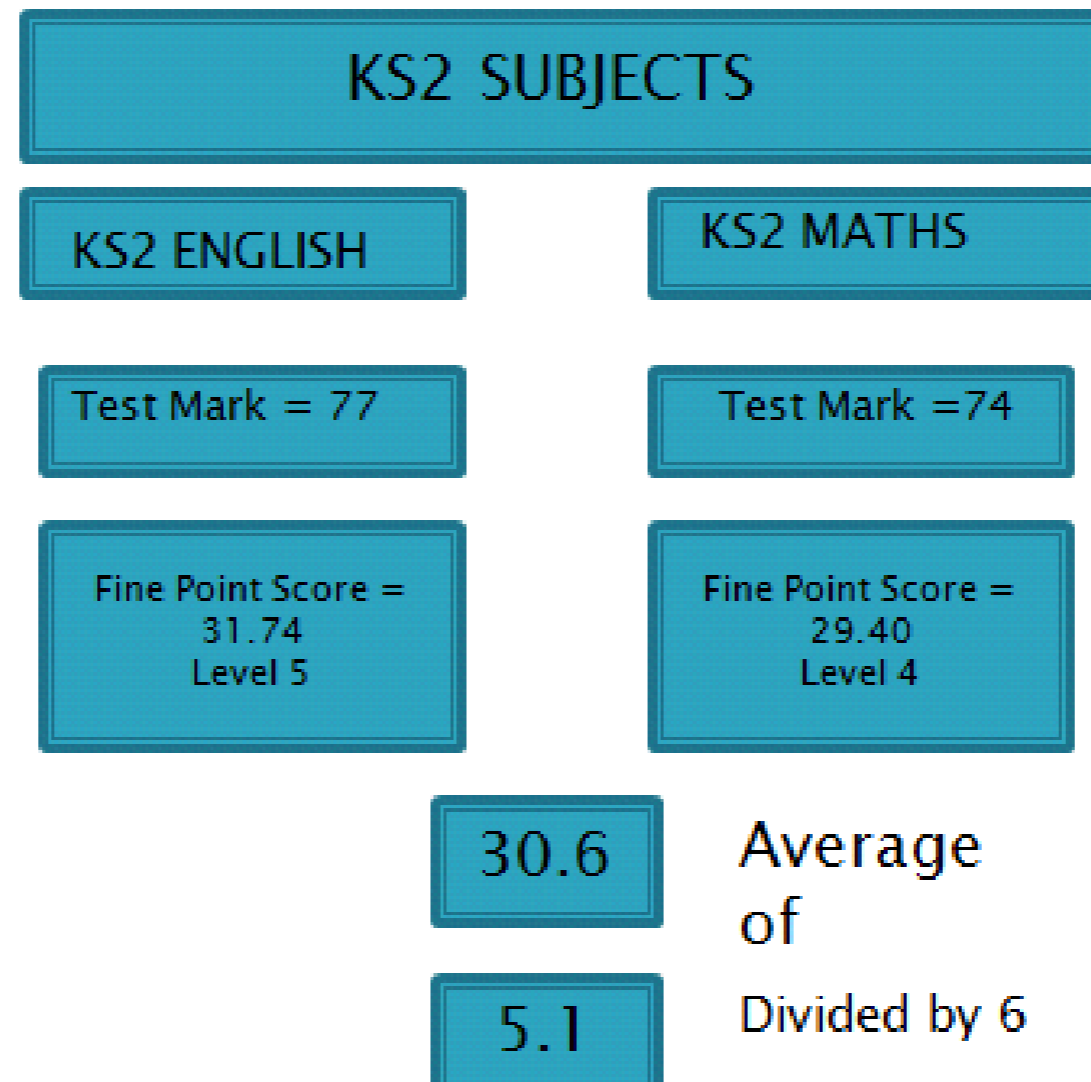
**The Progress 8 score will always be determined by dividing the points total by 10 (the eight qualifications with English and Mathematics counting double, regardless of how many qualifications your child sits or in which subjects).**

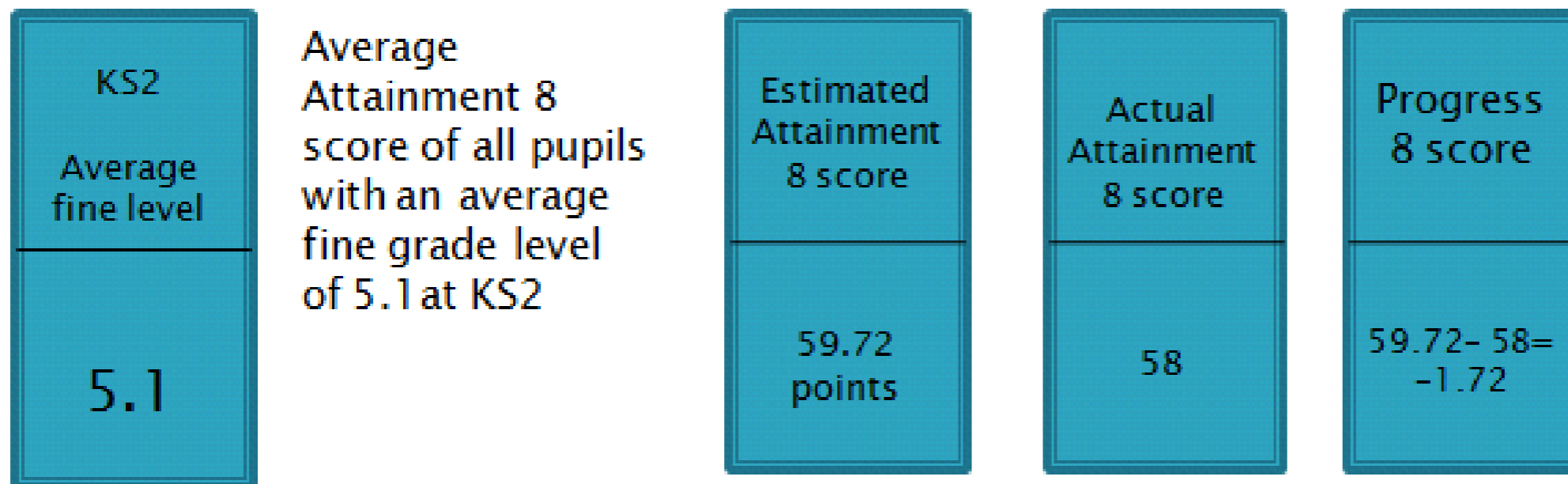

# Worked Example

- Pupils progress 8 score is calculated by the following:



## Worked Example

- -1.72 divided by 10 means that on average the pupil is -0.17 below other pupils of the same ability level.
- Below -1 – Serious Concern
- Below 0 and above -1 – Must Improve
- Above 0 and below 1 - Good
- Above 1 - Excellent
